Departments

Drawing Department -

It is very well equipped with all necessary aids. It provides a creative atmosphere for the students. We exhibit our paintings at National and International Level.

Laboratories

Language Lab -

In order to help students to attain fluency and accuracy in English phonetics, the College has fully air conditioned computerized Language Lab.

Computer & BCA Labs -

To introduce students about new technology, the college has 2 air conditioned Computer Labs with Wi-Fi connectivity.

Facilities

Library -

It is fully internet enabled and also equipped with an audio-visual media library.

The college provides fully furnished residency facility for the staff members and their families coming from all over the states. Principal resides in the complex for 24X7 help.

Games & Tournaments-

The college provides Indoor and Outdoor games facilities to our students. We also organise Inter College and Inter University Tournaments.

Wi-Fi Campus-

Infrastructure

Administrative Block -

It houses the office of the college. It also takes care of visitors for whom a separate area is provided where they can meet their children and the College Authorities.
